1. Examination schedule, Grade, Name, Age, and Number they will wear in the Exam must be sent to the Examination Secretary, six weeks prior to the examination.
2. Changes to the schedule are not allowed once the information has been processed.
3. If a student does not show up for his/her Examination do not change the number system. Examiners have prepared all examination reports ahead of time with the students name and number to save time during the examination.
4. Number of students and time allotted for examination.

** Please allow one ten-minute break and one half hour break for the Examiner when preparing the Examination schedule. ((i.e.) Two hours – 10 minutes Four hours – 30 minutes

1. All students **MUST** wear a number pinned on the front of their leotard. Please be sure the number is large enough for the Examiner to read when the students are moving around the room. Suitable size is 5 inches by 5 inches and preferably black number on white. Small pins should be placed on all four corners of the number to keep it flat. Numbers must run in consecutive order, 1 – 30 or higher. Do not repeat 1 2 3, 1 2 3, **Name and number should correspond with the Examination schedule.**
2. Student must take the Examination as stated on the entry form. No substitute or late entries will be accepted on the day of the Examination.
3. Teachers must conform to the requirements as set down in the Syllabus. Teachers must operate the music as well as teach the class from Preliminary Badge to the Grade Three Enrichment Level.
4. Students may take two Examinations on the same day as long as they are in order and it has been noted on the Examination form. Examination results from both Examinations will be available at the end of the day. Student must wear a different number for both Exams.
5. Music for the Grade Four and the Grade Five Examination is available on CD and is played by the Examiner. Music for the Grade Four and the Grade Five Enrichment Examination is available on separate CD's. Notes are available from the Ballet Chair. Information for ordering music may be obtained from the Ballet Chair.



Please provide a CD player within comfortable reach of the Examiner. CD player should have detachable speakers so students can hear the music.

6. The Examiner's table must be large enough to accommodate the Examiner's marking papers and other papers pertinent to the Examination (2002).
 - a. Table should be skirted, a suitable height and without any rough edges underneath.
 - b. A comfortable chair must be provided.
 - c. **Please cover all mirrors.**

7. Proper attire must be worn. Short or long sleeve leotard. Pink or Black.
(Students should wear the same colour but school colours are acceptable.)
Short skirts can be worn for Preliminary Badge.
White T-shirt with Black tights for Boys.
Ballet tights (pink). No runs please.
Pink or black ballet slippers. Ribbons are optional. Ribbons must be tied correctly. No bows.
No jewelry is to be worn. Medical bracelets are acceptable.
Hair must be neat and tidy. Preferably up in a bun.
No flowers or bows in the hair.

8. Props may be used during group dances in Badge/Enrichment Examinations. Props should be brought into the room and put on the floor upon entry for Examination.

9. Please remind students to acknowledge the Examiner with "Good Morning" or the appropriate acknowledgement for the time of day and also to say "Thank You" when leaving.

10. Students are reminded not to talk, laugh or move about when other students are demonstrating steps or answering questions.

11. Before leaving all students must return to the centre of the room and curtsey or bow, and then leave quietly.
